Secondly, on *First Fridays* we are cutting back the time for adoration: we will now end the adoration at 6:45 pm, and not continue after the mass at 7 pm.



**Stewardship Reflections** *Third Sunday of Easter April 30th, 2017*

Today's Gospel is a familiar story. Why did these men not immediately recognize Jesus? With all the busyness of modern life, do we sometimes miss opportunities to recognize Christ in our midst? "Stewardship always starts with a personal experience of the Risen Christ in our midst and in our hearts" (Bishop Sylvester D. Ryan).
